The objective of the Collaborative is to link families with resources that meet their needs and focus on well-being, safety, academic success, and the stability of the children in the communities in which it serves.

Through partnerships with community churches, businesses, and other organizations we coordinate the following services:

Wraparound Program

- A voluntary program to assist families with assessing their strengths, building a team of natural supports and making a plan to use strategies and goals to stabilize the family and make them successful by their own definition of success.

Helping Hands Initiatives

- **Backpacks and school supplies** – Partnership with Community/Business/Schools (CBS Connects) and community churches.
- **Coats for Kids** – Made possible by grant funding, donations, and partnership with community churches.
- **Holiday Adopt-A-Family** – Partnership with community individuals, churches, businesses and other organizations.

Home Liaisons

- Every Parma City School has Home Liaisons in the building. The role of a liaison is to work in cooperation with the school, staff and families to assist in overcoming barriers to academic success.
